



Bulk-item Remove

Republic Services will collect furniture and other large, non-metal household items placed curbside for items equivalent to 2 cubic yards (4'x4'x4') and weighing less than 50 lbs. Resident should contact the Customer Resource Center at 703-818-8222 to schedule service at no charge. Bulk to be placed beside trash carts for pickup Thursday. Examples of acceptable items include:

- Furniture- includes sofas, couch, end-table, , dining-room table- all glass tops/mirrors must be taped and wrapped in plastic
- Lawn furniture
- Push-Lawnmowers (oil and gas must be drained)
- Area Rug/Carpet (maximum of one 9' x 11' size, per pickup)
- Basketball goals (pole must be broken down to 4' to fit in collection vehicle)
- Bicycles (non-motorized)

Items not listed above and weighing more than 50 lbs. would need to be arranged for appropriate removal, to include applicable charges directly to the resident. Resident should contact the Customer Resource Center at 703-818-8222 for service and make payment arrangements of \$85.00. **White-Goods/Appliances must be FREON-FREE and tagged by a certified HVAC Technician prior to removal.** Examples include:

- Air Conditioners (window units)
- Dishwashers
- Hot Water Heaters
- Microwaves
- Metal Bookshelves/File Cabinets
- Refrigerators
- Freezers
- Stoves
- Washers & Dryers

NOTE: Contractor generated materials, construction and demolition, automotive parts/tires/rims, disaster relief debris, exempt or hazardous wastes will not be collected. This also includes all electronics and we do not accept any liquid paints or liquid household cleaners.

Please recycle only the items below:



PLASTICS

Recycle plastics #1 - #7. Look on the bottom of containers for the number inside the recycling arrows.



METAL CANS, ALUMINUM FOIL, ALUMINUM FOIL PANS

Recycle all food and beverage metal cans — steel, tin, bi-metal and aluminum.



CARDBOARD, NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINES

Recycle newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books and brochures.



PAPER FOOD CONTAINERS

Recycle juice boxes, egg, ice cream and milk cartons, and cereal and pasta boxes.



PAPER

Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards and file folders. Shredded paper should be put in a paper bag.

Polystyrene foam

Holiday decorations
Hardback books
